

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What about sports?
 - a. Calvary Christian School will offer soccer, volleyball, basketball, and golf for the first couple of years to full-time students as well as area homeschoolers taking classes at CCS. During this time, eighth graders will be included if needed to have full teams. As Calvary High School increases in number of team players between school years, the 8th graders would return to junior high status.
2. How can one teacher handle the whole freshman class?
 - a. During the summer of 2012 we will hire a new teacher. This teacher will have a math-science background at the high school level.
 - b. In order to utilize this teacher for both the freshman and sophomore years, the schedule will alternate the core curriculum each year. For example, during the year 2012-13 we will be teaching Physical Science to all freshman and sophomores. During the year 2013-14, we will be teaching Biology to all freshman and sophomores. This will allow us to teach the same curriculum to two different levels of students at the same time. As always, classes will be assigned to teachers to fit teaching strengths as close as possible.
 - c. This "alternating schedule" will be replicated with math, English and social study classes. Therefore, English I and English II will be offered on alternate years. Likewise, World History and American History will be offered alternately. During the 2014-15-16 years, American Literature and World Literature will be offered on alternating years as well as Government and Economics.
 - d. Sample copies of those schedules are included at the end of this document. Realize that these schedules change with enrollment, teachers and other factors.
3. What subjects are you teaching at the high school?
 - a. Our curriculum was based on Ohio core requirements for graduation (2010-11) to satisfy state requirements. We attempted to mimic the neighboring schools as close as possible in order to allow a smooth transition for students coming from the public system. In addition, we require a credit of Bible for each year the student is enrolled in Calvary.
 - b. A copy of the curriculum is included at the end of this document.
4. Will our students be prepared for college?
 - a. Calvary Christian High School will offer rigorous and challenging college prep courses in the curriculum. Students will be prepared to enter college because they will have the option to take the plan test--10th grade oriented (pre-act test), act test, sat and the psat test for 11th or 12th.
5. Can they take college courses while in high school?
 - a. Calvary Christian High School students can take college courses but not through the Post Secondary Enrollment Option which is funded by the state.
6. What about foreign languages?
 - a. Foreign language will be offered for four years through a part-time aide/teacher or via online classes with Rosettastone or Fluenz. The cost of the part-time aide/teacher is already incorporated into the budget. If suitable personnel are not found for the year, the cost of online program will be offset by the planned aide costs.

7. How will a home school student connect?
 - a. We are interested in offering on-line classes blended with already existing, high school classes. By offering these classes to the homeschooler, they get the advantage of participating in a real class. Blended learning, which integrates online instruction into the traditional classroom, is becoming increasingly popular. In fact, experts predict that [half of all K–12 learning will be delivered online by 2019.](#)
 - b. Students that reside off-site will connect via the Internet, using the programs Skype and Moodle. Skype is a free video conferencing program that allows face-to-face Talk with live video. The student will connect during class to conference with the teacher and class. This allows peer interaction as well as teacher-student communication. The only requirement of the student is Internet access and a webcam. Homework, handouts, quizzes and tests will be coordinated through a Learning Management System called Moodle. The program allows for collection and distribution of classroom material, dissemination of grades, and the advantage of “anytime” learning.
 - c. Teachers will be available at their classroom computers through Skype for one-on-one teacher/student conferences. Classes can be recorded and made available online to absent students or students needing a review.
8. What other extracurricular activities will be available?
 - a. Calvary Christian High School will offer Chapel Band, Audio/Video Production, Student Council, Fellowship of Christian Athletes and CCHS Honor Society. If there is sufficient interest, other academic clubs could be offered as science, math, debate or art.
 - b. There will also be opportunities for HS students to be involved in service opportunities either through area churches, the above named clubs, or other organizations already existing in the community. Not only will this foster a servant's heart and a realization of others' needs, it will give CCHS added exposure and provide natural public relations opportunities.
9. How will the addition of the high school affect the lower grades? Are the high school student separated from the elementary?
 - a. High School students will take their classes in the Uth building. Although there may be some movement of students together with the elementary, most interaction will not occur.
 - b. But, there is an added advantage to having High School students in our school. Students make excellent peer tutors for the younger generation. These role-models provide added support for the teachers as well as familiarity with the older generation. From the aspect of the high school student, there is no better reinforcing mechanism for their curricula, than to teach the subject to their younger schoolmates.
10. What about classroom facilities? Where will the classrooms be?
 - a. The Uth building has additional classroom space for the new teachers. There is currently sufficient extra furniture to get us through the first year of the high school. Additional funds have been implemented into the budget for the succeeding years.
 - b. The science classes will share the lab facility
 - c. Music classes will share facilities as well.
