


Calvary Christian School New Campus Plan Spring 2025

Building on the Rock Campaign Update

Time to celebrate! 🎉

All of our Phase 1 and Phase 2 projects are now complete! We are praising the Lord for all that He has done in a very short window! Everything at this property that has been will facilitate student life transformation and includes projects like site work, utilities, classrooms, library, the cafeteria, outdoor eating patio, parking lots, gym, and more are all finished with a cost of \$11.8 million dollars! We've paid \$5 million dollars towards this project to date; we have a \$6 million dollar mortgage through Middlefield Bank. This has been a dream for many people in our area that are passionate about Christian education and we get to live it! We are very thankful and very blessed!

We're praising God for the progress we've seen and the miracles it took to get us to this point and we will continue to trust Him as He guides our next steps in campus development and debt payoff. We want to be aggressive with paying off the debt to ensure long-term viability and to keep us in a position to take advantage of opportunities that present themselves.

We have started discussions on future campus enhancements. Athletic facilities development as well as a future junior high and high school academic building (phase 3) is on the horizon. Our goal is to publish a facilities development playbook before this school year is over to show a projected timeline and order of future projects at this new campus.

Arrival Time

- School times have not changed.
 - K4-3rd grade school runs 8:15am-3:00pm.
 - 4th-12th grade school runs 8:00am- 3:15pm.
- Campus doors will open at **7:45am**.
- 4th-12th grade students may go directly to their homeroom at 7:45am.
- K4-3rd grade classrooms open at 8:05am.
 - Morning supervision will be available in the cafeteria for students from 7:45am until classrooms open.

Gym Shoes!

Our new gymnasium is going to be a well-loved room! We've joked that once the lights turn on they may never turn off again! In an effort to protect the longevity of the surface we're adding a rule that students need to have a specific pair of gym shoes they keep in their locker and change into when they will be using that space. These can be new shoes but they don't have to be! Feel free to clean up a used pair and designate those as their gym specific shoes if that works best. Besides the floor streaking that certain shoes do, the biggest thing we have to avoid are the small pebbles or rocks that get stuck in the grooves of a shoe. Those rocks will scratch up the floor and there's no easy fix when that happens so we're asking our families to help us avoid that!

Lunch, Chapel, and K5-3rd Grade Specials

Lunch will continue to be served this year from Tuesday-Friday which means Monday will be the day to pack lunch. All students will eat in the cafeteria (woohoo)! 🎉

K4-3rd grade chapel will be moved to Fridays from 9:00-9:45am. 4th-12th grade chapel will continue to be on Fridays from 8:00-9:00am. Mr. Joey Adams (Mr. Adams has his BA in Biblical Studies and M Div from Cedarville University) will continue to serve as school chaplain and will direct chapel services at CCS. The chapel program includes a student worship team leading chapel all year, two spiritual reset weeks (at the start of each semester), and an evangelism conference in March.

K5-3rd grade students will still have weekly specials, they will just now be on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (art, gym, music, technology). Mrs. White will continue to teach art and music, Mrs. Carter will continue to teach gym, and Mrs. Dillon will continue to teach technology.

Backpacks:

We are asking that student backpacks stay in their lockers and not be transported from class to class. We're implementing this change now because students won't be walking outside to get to a class in a separate building and their lockers will also be located near the bulk of their classes. Keeping backpacks in lockers will help keep the campus clean and will literally take weight off the students' shoulders!

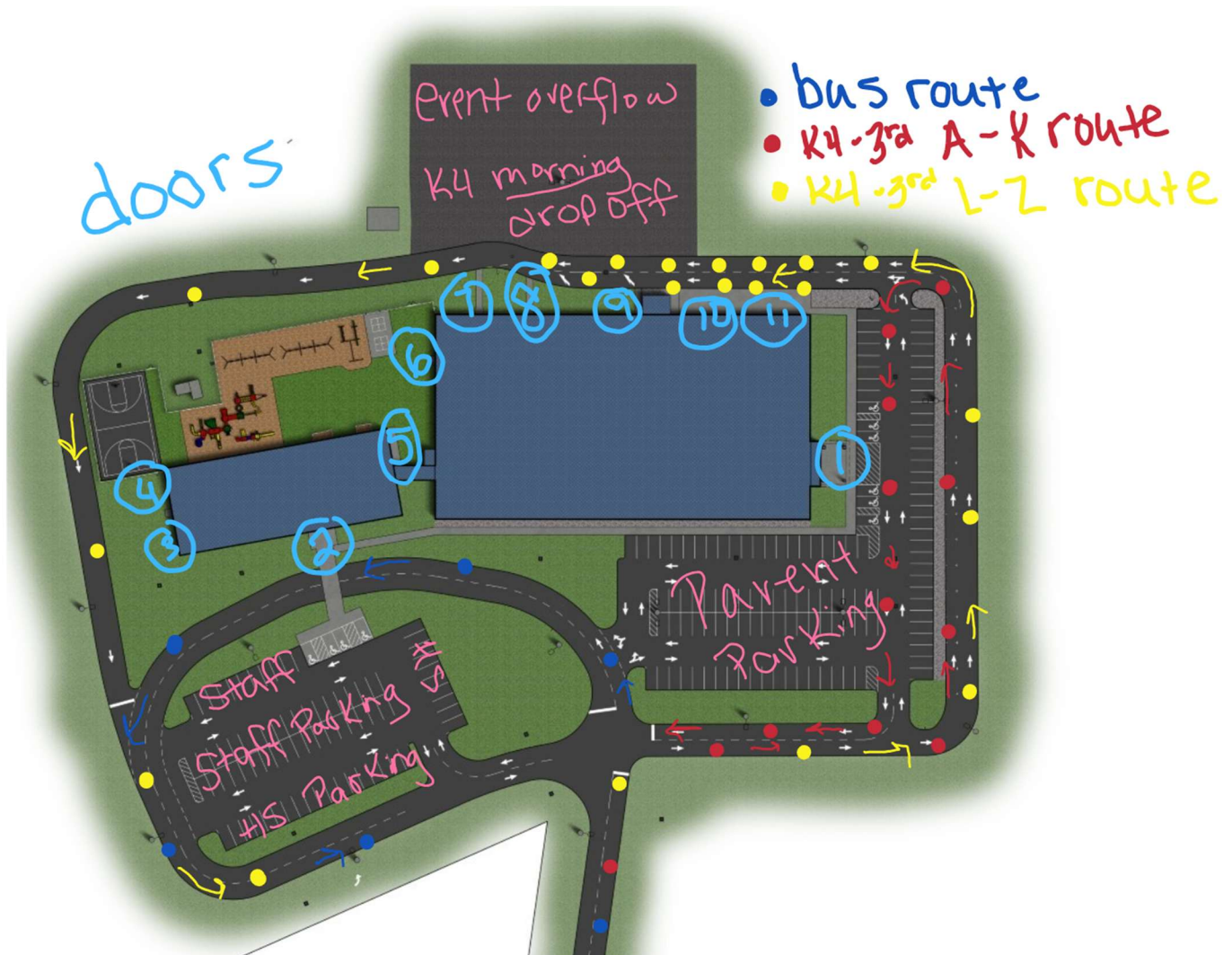
After-School Care

After-School care will no longer need a shuttle from one campus to another! Time to celebrate!!! 🎉

After-School care will be located in room 5010 (phase one building). Door two (see campus map below) will be the best spot to park and come in to pick up your child.

Remember after-school families to keep filling out the monthly forms for which day your child(ren) will attend after-school care. The after-school tile on the app will be updated over Christmas break with all the correct information!

Parking Lot, Drop Off, and Pickup



Parking Lots:

- Parking Lot outside of phase one
 - High school parking (back row and left row)
 - Staff
- Parking Lot outside of phase two
 - Parent parking
- Parking Lot behind phase two (gravel lot)
 - K4 morning parking
 - Overflow parking for events

Drop Off:

- Busses will use the loop outside of phase one building (door 2)
- Parents will use the loop outside of door 1 in phase two

- K4 will park in the overflow parking lot and walk students into door 8 so that they can check in at their classroom

Pickup:

- Busses will use the loop outside of phase one building (door 2)
- K4-3rd grade parents A-K will use the loop outside phase two (door 1)
- K4-3rd grade parent L-Z will use loop to the back door (door 10)
- 4th-12th grade parents will park and students will be released to them at 3:15pm from door 1 and 2

Other Pickup Reminders:

- If you are a K4-3rd grade parent and you have not picked up your child by **3:15pm** your child will be moved to the cafeteria and can be picked up at **door ten** from 3:15-3:30pm. After **3:30pm** your child will be placed in after school care and you will be charged a drop-in fee (\$20). After 3:30pm you can park in the staff/ HS student parking lot and walk in **door two** to pick your child up from room 5010 (after school care room).
- 4th-12th Grade Parents that pick up your children: 4-12 grade students are dismissed at 3:15 and should locate their ride at that time. Our suggestion is to attempt to locate a particular pick-up area, so students know where to find you. Parents are welcome to park and walk to our lobby area (inside door 1) and meet your student there. If for whatever reason the students ride is not at Calvary at 3:15, please help us train those students to move to the lobby area and wait there until their ride arrives. We do not want these students anywhere else on campus until they locate their ride home.
- Older siblings picking up younger siblings: please come to the cafeteria as soon as the bell rings to gather your younger siblings.
- If your child rides the bus and their bus has not arrived when the bell rings, they need to congregate in the cafeteria. We will then escort them to the bus as it arrives.
