The Accreditation is Advancing!

The admin team and Teachers/staff – all hands on deck are working on a process called Accreditation. This is a third-party organization (ACSI and Cognia) that looks at every part of the operation of our school to rate our compliance and quest for excellence. Nothing is hidden as we look at business practice, finances, curriculum, extra-curricular, leadership systems, and all of this with an understanding of biblical Integration and mission focus. This is why we have four Accreditation Inservice days – kids off. The process is and will make us better! It will honor the practices we do well and shine a light on the items we need to improve. Hey, no body is perfect, but the quest to improve grow and be excellent is a constant march you see in the Calvary way.

The Building is Taking Shape!

We love our building, and we are so glad to be here! It is unbelievable that we sit in a property valued at \$12 million dollars!! This is the same school that spent many years



wondering if we could pay our staff or even open school the next year! What a blessing to have secured the funds from you our donors to create professional, roomy space to do our work to the best of our ability. No one comes to our school and leaves unimpressed! The building itself screams we want to do Christian Education right! What a blessing a couple of months ago when we were able to host 400-ish people for the New Path Pregnancy Center banquet. They were impressed with our gym, sound system, lighting and stage — it was perfect for them! What a blessing to have the resources, the equipment, the space, to bless our community!



Ohio Educational Choice State:

We had a great visit with our State House of Representative yesterday, Tim Barhorst. He represents the 85th District at the State House in Columbus.



Rep. Barhorst and the rest of the Ohio Assembly have been very good to us through the Ed-Choice voucher program. This provision has allowed your tax dollars to follow our students to the school of their choice making Calvary accessible to anyone who wants and values Christian Education. Mr. Hyde and I have spent a fair amount of time in Columbus the past several years making sure the State legislators know the value they bring to our community and our school. We continue to work out a second-to-none educational experience that brings in the best of public education with a Christian/Biblical worldview.

Also note the amazing Tax Credit available to us when you donate to the SGO link found on the Calvary Website and get a total write off that allows you to pay nothing and direct your Ohio Tax liability to the Calvary school financial aid program. That means that we can continue to be helpful to those families who struggle to pay the tuition gap between the Ed-Choice scholarship and the amount they must pay out of pocket. Again, blessing upon blessing as the Lord continues to work out systems to make the mission of Christian Education real and viable!!
