

# CLAIMING THE STATE TAX CREDIT FOR YEARLY SGO DONATION

## Owe at least a \$750 in state taxes

- Up to \$1500 can be claimed for couples Married Filing Jointly
- Anyone whose taxable income is over \$44,250 owes a minimum of \$878.42 in state tax.
- Taxable state income can be found on page 2 of your state income tax return line 13.

Ohio Taxable Income	Tax Calculation
\$0-\$25,000	0.000%
\$25,001 - \$44,250	\$346.16 + 2.765% of excess over \$25,000
\$44,250 - \$ 88,450	\$878.42 + 3.226% of excess over \$44,250
\$88,450 - \$110,650	\$2,304.31 + 3.688 % of excess over \$88,450
more than \$110,650	\$3,123.05 + 3.990 of excess over \$110,650

- Finish filling out the form and submit. You will receive a receipt to keep and use for filing your taxes.
- You can donate for the 2024 tax year until APRIL 15TH, 2025. You may only make one donation per tax year.



## Claim on the Ohio Schedule of Credits

- In 2024 the Scholarship Donation Credit was line 15. If you file with a tax preparer or software it is called, "Scholarship Donation Credit".
- Include your receipt (either the emailed receipt or the hard copy OCEN SGO mails in January).
